

His career began in 1992 as co-founder of a small advertising photography studio after studying photography for five years at the Barcelona school of photography (IEFC). Currently, he collaborates nationally and internationally with some of the most important print media: Architectural Digest,

Wallpaper, Interni, Abitare, Arquitectura y Diseño, El País Semanal, Magazine (of La Vanguardia) among others. Eugeni Pons' interest in experimental photography, landscape design and architecture, has won him five LUX awards in the architectural photography category. He has also participated in various exhibitions, the most recent, Barcelona-Madrid, presented by the Architects Association in Madrid. In 2004, he had a solo exhibition of his work at Sala Greek in Barcelona.



## WOOD INTERIORS



## CITY HOUSES. Urban Single Family Houses, Apartments, Lofts and Studios
